Scripture & Questions

Monday

Scripture: Mark 1:21-45

Question: What are your thoughts about the type of healing mentioned in our passage today? Do you have any experiences you could share?

Tuesday

Scripture: Mark 2:1-12

Question: There are many people in this world who need help getting to Jesus, Adam Hamilton calls them “stretcher-bearers.” Can you remember a time when you were a stretcher-bearer to someone, or maybe you needed someone to help you?

Wednesday

Scripture: Luke 10:25-37

Question: Yesterday, we talked about being “stretcher-bearers” for others. Today, I want to ask you who those “others” are in your life?

Thursday

Scripture: John 5:1-15

Question: We all know someone who seems to want to live in pain and sickness, almost looking for pity from those around them, but Jesus comes and asks us, “Do you want to get well?” Do we want to get well, or do we want our condition to define us?

Friday

Scripture: Mark 5:21-43

Question: Do you have the faith of the woman who was healed of bleeding of 12 years? Do you just want to touch the hem of Jesus’ robe?

Saturday

Scripture: John 4:43-54

Question: So often we look for signs and wonders, but sometimes healing comes without a big display of power. In our story from this morning, Jesus heals a man’s son, even without being there. When was the last time you experienced God in a quiet, unassuming way?
