***Scripture & Questions***

**Monday**

Scripture: Luke 24:36-49

Question: I always found this passage from Luke to be interesting. Jesus asks for something to eat. While this could have been to prove he was alive, I wonder if it is also a reminder for us to stay hungry. Are there things in your spiritual life you are hungry for?

**Tuesday**

Scripture: Acts 3:11-26

Question: Do we still fall into the same trap of disowning Jesus, asking for evil to be set free?

**Wednesday**

Scripture: John 15:1-17

Question: Jesus' words remind us that we need others along this journey. Who might God be calling you to invite to join us?

**Thursday**

Scripture: 1 Peter 2:11-25

Question: Peter tells us that doing good will silence the foolish. Can you think of a time when you witnessed an act of kindness which exposed those who were not so kind?

**Friday**

Scripture: Exodus 16:11-36

Question: God provided manna for the Israelites and gave instructions not to hoard or save it for the next day, but many of them did and it spoiled. What does this tell us about the human condition and our trust in God's provisions?

**Saturday**

Scripture: Exodus 17:1-17

Question: Whenever the Israelites felt like they didn't have what they needed, they blamed Moses and God. The need was then provided for, and the people thanked God, but it never lasted long. Do you this today in the life of the church, of Journey of Hope?
