Monday

Scripture: Exodus 6:1-13

Question: Moses felt unqualified to speak to the Pharoah for God because of his speech

impediment. Is there an obstacle for you to share the Good News with others?

Tuesday

Scripture: Exodus 12:1-30

Question: What celebrations do you have in your family that you hold regularly? What story do

those celebrations or remembrances tell?

Wednesday

Scripture: Exodus 13:17-22

Question: It may not seem like a pillar of clouds or fire, but when was the last time you felt like

God was leading you on your journey?

Thursday

Scripture: Exodus 16:1-12

Question: In the midst of their journey, the Israelites began to complain, thinking it was better

back in Egypt. Can you think of a time you would like to "go back to?" But things aren't always what we remember. After reflection, would you still want to return?

Friday

Scripture: Exodus 18:13-27

Question: Is there something in your life that you refuse to ask help for? Why? Who is willing to

help if you would just ask?

Saturday

Scripture: Exodus 20:1-21

Question: Moses receives the ten commandments, rules to live by. But we remember that Jesus

told us the greatest were to love God and love our neighbor. How can following those

two help us in following the ten listed in Exodus?
