Monday

Scripture: John 20:19-31

Question: How do you feel about doubts and questions, especially about your faith? Do you truly

feel there is a place for questions about faith?

Tuesday

Scripture: Luke 24:13-35

Question: There are times in our lives when circumstances overpower our thoughts and

emotions, but someone else's perspective helps us in our struggles. Have you had someone help you in a time like this? Have you been an outside perspective for

someone else?

Wednesday

Scripture: Luke 24:36-49

Question: We are called to be witnesses of our faith and experiences. What events in your life can

you use to share a witness of God's love and protection?

Thursday

Scripture: Matthew 25:1-30

Question: So many conversations happen every day about the end times and when it might be.

But Jesus' words tell us that we will not know the day nor the hour. How can you find

comfort in this truth of not knowing?

Friday

Scripture: Acts 10:1-33

Question: I think we are, at times, like Peter, tied to our firm belief in tradition. But then God

speaks words to us of acceptance and change. Will we be like Peter and heed the words

of change?

Saturday

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 15:35-49

Question: While we should talk about resurrection all year long, we focus heavily on it around

Easter. In our passage from Paul today, we hear about physical and spiritual bodies. What are your thoughts around your resurrection? Will it be spiritual, or physical?
